Other Site Characteristics

Between the villages Tarnava and Altimir along the river there is comparatively broad strip of Salix alba, Populus nigra, Populus alba, Quercus robur and Fraxinus oxycarpa (91E0). GPS - E 023 51` 56`` N 43 34` 541.2 km on the north of Altimir near the road there is an old picturesque watermill. Close to the mill there is a dense forest of Fraxinus oxycarpa (91F0) with high conservational value and must be protected. The part of the river in the region of Altimir is one of the few left habitats of Gobio anoscopus. In Skat River are found 3 fish species included in Annex 2 of Directive 92/43.

4.2 Quality and importance

The site is important for the preservation of salt meadows, small survive alluvial forest, and some steppe communities with the rare endemic species Centaurea rumelica. The part of the river in the region of Altimir is one of the few left habitats of Gobio anoscopus. In Skat River are found 3 fish species included in Annex 2 of Directive 92/43.
